Dear constituent,

Thank you for your enquiry about congratulatory messages for people celebrating a milestone birthday.

As your local MP I can arrange messages from the Prime Minister, the Governor-General and the Queen, as well as the person's State Member of Parliament, their State Premier and the State Governor.

The Prime Minister sends messages to people celebrating their 90th or 100<sup>th</sup> birthday. Those celebrating their 100th birthday will also receive a message from the Governor-General and the Queen.

People who reside outside the Hume electorate will not receive a message from me but your request will be referred to their own local MP as a courtesy and as protocol dictates.

Applications should be lodged no earlier than eight weeks and no later than five weeks before the birthday. If a person's circumstances change after you have lodged the application, it is important that you contact me so we can avoid upset or embarrassment.

Belated messages can be arranged within one month of the special occasion.

When returning the application form, by either post or fax, please include a photocopy of the person's birth certificate. When a copy can't be obtained, a member of the family must complete the attached statutory declaration form and have it witnessed by a justice of the peace.
